WHAT IS NEEDED TO CONNECT:

- \$100—Monthly DSL connection.
- \$500—Laptop Computer, with webcam.
- \$ 65—Vidyo Program (one-time)
- \$ 75— Modem (one-time)

This is unlimited teaching for about \$1800 for first year and \$1200 thereafter.
